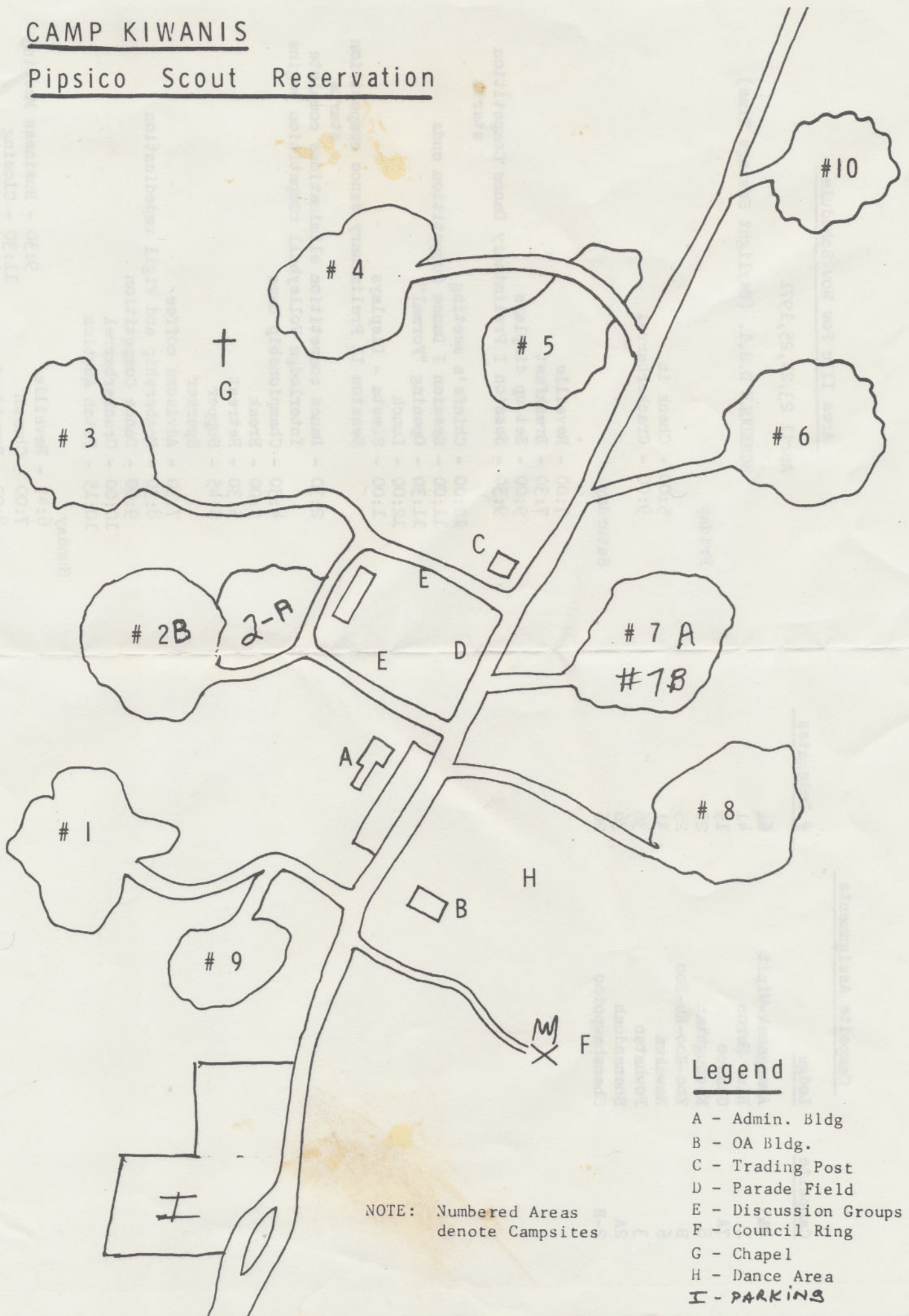

VOLLEYBALL

Twnty-one (21) points with a two point advantage wins the game. Points can only be obtained by team serving. There is a nine (9) player maximum on the field with no more than three adults participating at one time.

Substitutions are allowed only when your team is serving. Ball must be hit, and can not be trapped and thrown. Touching the net is a penalty, which allows the opposing team to win the volley.

Ball can only be hit three times per volley, and a player may not hit the ball twice in succession.

Serve must be played within servers box.
