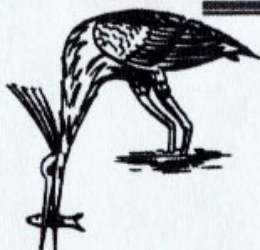


Fellow Arrowmen,

## Section SR-7A 2001 Conclave Participation Pin Requirement Form

Participation pins, which accompany this year's Conclave patch, may be purchased from the trading post for a nominal amount. To be eligible for the participation pin, you must complete the requirements as indicated below. (Lodge Chiefs or Advisers may sign for items 1d, 1e, 1f, 2e, and 2f. Each participant may sign for items 1g and 2b, based on their obligation of honesty, in order to complete the form in time to receive the participation pin.)

**1. Complete ALL of the following:**

- a. Obtain the signature of TWO elected lodge officers or advisers from lodges other than your own.
- b. Obtain the signature of ONE current or past elected Section, Regional, or National Officer.
- c. Attend TWO training sessions.
- d. Attend the Saturday night show.
- e. Assist your lodge in the afternoon sporting events. Participation in a ceremony or serving as a judge may be substituted for this requirement.
- f. Wear your official scout uniform to retreat ceremony and dinner.
- g. Make a commitment to complete the Section Conclave evaluation form.

**2. Complete any THREE of the following:**

- a. Compete in a Native American dance, singing, or regalia contest.
- b. Make a commitment to be in attendance at the Section elections.
- c. Attend a meet-the-man session.
- d. Attend the Section Officer Candidate Forum.
- e. Assist in preparation of Lodge's food item for the Section Block Party and Feast.
- f. Attend a religious service.
- g. Donate a patch towards the section patch auction.

### Conclave Delegate Code of Conduct

The success of the 2001 SR-7A Conclave depends highly on the behavior of its participants. Thus, there are responsibilities of which we must all be aware of in order for the Conclave to be safe, rewarding, and fun. Accepting and standing behind the following guidelines will ensure a great 2001 Conclave for all!

I, \_\_\_\_\_, as a member of the Order of the Arrow, and a participant at the 2001 SR-7A Conclave, do hereby promise to uphold and follow the Code of Conduct

- Observe the Scout Oath, the Scout Law, and the Order of the Arrow Obligation;
- Wear my official Scout uniform throughout the 2001 Conclave;
- Attend all planned training and general sessions;
- Be personally responsible for breakage, damage or loss of any camp, delegate, or lodge property;
- Keep myself and my environment clean;
- Not to leave the Pipsico Scout Reservation without the permission of my Lodge Chief, Lodge Adviser, and notifying the Conclave Administration;
- Respect all rules regarding vehicles in camp;
- Remember above all, at all times, have fun!!!

Deviation from any of the above guidelines will result in the immediate removal of the delegate from the activities, or camp and possibly from the Conclave. The Conclave Leadership reserves the right to add or revise guidelines, decide any dispute, or any other action necessary to safely complete Conclave operations.

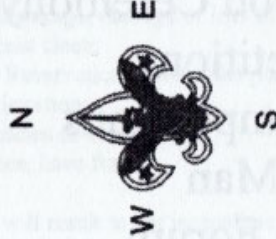

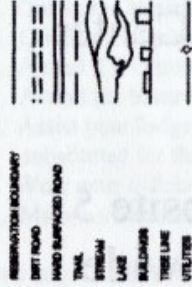

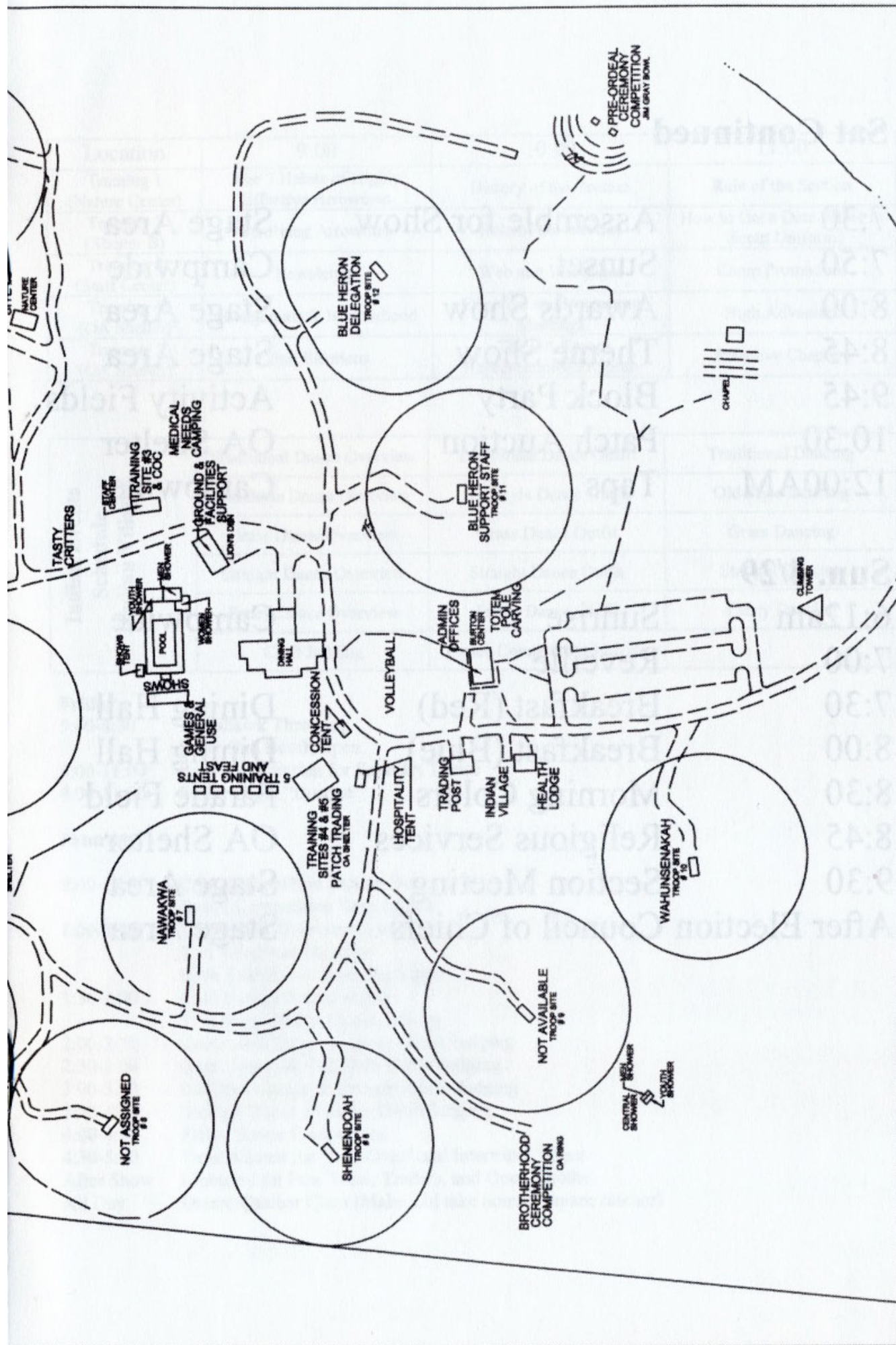
