Guidelines While Attending Conclave

- All activities will be governed by the Scout Oath and the Scout Law.
- Vehicles are restricted to designated parking areas except by special permit.
- Anyone needing special assistance should inform their Host Lodge Guide or either Camp Office.
- OPEN FIRES are restricted to the hours of 4:00 pm to 11:30 pm and limited to established campfire areas.
- Information is available at either Camp Office.
- Any emergencies should be reported to either Camp Office (each will be manned 24 hours per day).
- Trained medical personnel will be available at the CAC Health Lodge 24 hours per day. First Aid will be available at the CTBS Health Lodge at night.




